**Subject:- OA No. 300/2013 titled Manoj Mishra Vs. Union of India & Others before Hon'ble NGT.**

Whereas, Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) passed various orders in O.A No. 300 of 2013 in the matter of Manoj Mishra Vs. Union of India & Ors., and in O.A. No.196/2014 in the matter of Krishan Kant Singh Vs. National Ganga Basin Authority and Ors., for controlling water pollution from the industries discharging effluent in River Ganga and its Tributaries..

Whereas, State Level Committee constituted by Hon'ble NGT in O.A. No 196/2014 has decided to close down following type of Seriously Water Polluting Industries (SPIs Generating Hazardous Waste) in NCT of Delhi by September, 2016.

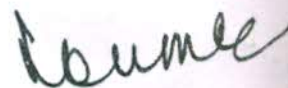
- (i) Industry or process involving metal surface treatment or process such as pickling/ electroplating/ phosphating / anodizing/ galvanizing etc.
- (ii) Yarn/textile processing involving bleaching, dyeing, printing and scouring etc.

And Whereas, Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) on the basis of available records has identified 493 units as SPIs from the list of 33 categories of Seriously Water Polluting Industries. Details of 33 SPIs are placed at Annexure-I. Details of 493 units are placed at Annexure-II. Details of 316 SPIs issued closure directions are placed at Annexure-III. Details of 177 SPIs having CTE/CTO are placed at Annexure-IV. Details of all the above also placed on the website of DPCC ([www.dpcc.delhigovt.nic.in](http://www.dpcc.delhigovt.nic.in)).

Now therefore, you are hereby directed to ensure that these 33 categories of SPIs do not operate without valid Consent to Establish (CTE) and Consent to Operate (CTO) of DPCC with immediate effect in areas falling under your respective jurisdiction. If any unit is found operating without consent of DPCC, complete details of the unit shall be provided to DPCC within seven days by post, fax or Email as per following details:

It is once again clarified that if any of the above categories of industries is found to be operating without valid Consent to Establish/Consent to Operate (CTE/CTO), the concerned agency will be held responsible and the matter shall be reported to Hon'ble NGT for directions to **levy fine as per the Polluter Pay Principle.**
