	contempt proceedings be not initiated against them as well as the Order of attachment within the purview of Order 21 of the Code of Civil Procedure be not passed against them for contempt of wilful disobedience and non-compliance of the Order of the Tribunal which are treated as decree of the civil court in terms of the provisions of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010. We also issue Notice to show cause to these authorities why they not be directed to pay cost for unnecessary adjournment as despite our repeated directions, there is not even an effort to comply with the directions. The initial comprehensive Order was passed by the Tribunal on 28th November, 2014 and 4th December, 2014. Its default was noticed and further directions were issued by our subsequent Orders. Last opportunity was granted vide our Order dated 17th February, 2015. List the matters on 16th March, 2015. All the directions passed by the Tribunal shall be complied and all concerned authorities should carry them out without default and delay.
